









Seeking Surrey SEND schools interested in working with Stopgap Dance Company

Stopgap Dance Company and Culture Box Surrey, working in partnership, are seeking expressions of interest from SEND schools who would like to be involved in an exciting creative dance project designed to enable students to achieve Arts Award accreditation.

Project description

This project involves a series of dance workshops taking place at your school, run by Stopgap Dance Company. The design of the project itself is flexible and a key element is that of co-design: the project partners (Culture Box Surrey and Stopgap Dance Company) will meet with you to establish your aims and objectives for the project and then run a pilot workshop at the school where the final project design can be refined. As an example the project could include: the initial meeting, the pilot workshop, a series of half-day workshops and a final CPD session for teachers (or a final session to support your Arts Award documentation), all designed to support your pupils to achieve Arts Award.

When will the project take place?

Workshop dates can be negotiated directly between your school and Stopgap Dance company. It is envisaged that the project design and pilot workshops should be completed by the end of the summer term 2022 with the full project roll out commencing in the autumn term.

How much does it cost schools?

There is no charge to schools for participation but schools will be expected to demonstrate they have the capacity to ensure the project is successful. Participating schools must commit to:

- Providing a project facilitator who is either a member of, or who has the clear support of, the school's SLT, and who can liaise with Stopgap Dance
- A member of staff willing to train as an Arts Award Adviser via an online training session
- Attending a pre-project planning meeting (online), and a meeting immediately after the pilot session
- Collaborating with an evaluator who will gather staff and young people's responses to the programme

If we are oversubscribed we will prioritise schools who can best demonstrate their capacity as above, and who are:

- interested in embedding Arts Award accreditation in their school
- registered for Artsmark accreditation for their cultural learning offer
